Ohio



- ▶ Population: 11,570,808
- ▶ Capital City: Columbus (809, 798)
 - Seaman & Sardinia, Oh < 1,000

- ▶ Famous for the unpredictable weather
- ▶ Home to the tallest roller coaster, 400ft. Drop
- ▶ 7 Presidents came from Ohio, 1 from Brown County
- ▶ Pro-football and Rock n' Roll Hall of Fame
- ▶ Serpent Mound

Cincinnati

- ▶ Population of Cincinnati: 296,550
 - 3rd largest city
- ▶ Sports city
 - The Reds, Bengals, and Cyclones
 - Red's=first major baseball team
- ▶ Rich in German culture
 - Oktoberfest
- ▶ Right on the Ohio River
- ▶ Major rivalry with Pittsburgh and St. Louis



The University of Cincinnati

- ▶ Over 42,000 students
- ▶ 17 colleges
 - More than 500 undergraduate programs
- ▶ 80 international countries represented
- ▶ Class 1 research institution
 - 1 or 88 in whole country



UC Clermont College

- ▶ Located in Batavia, OH
 - Less than an hour outside Cincinnati
- ▶ Transitional school, mainly used for first two years of study
- ▶ More flexible and affordable
 - Geared towards those who are working or wanting to go back to school



Studying in the United States

▶ Class Schedule

- Choose own schedule
- Same class 2–3 days a week, or once at night

▶ Exam Schedule

- 1 exam week at the end
- Some teachers give midterm exams
- Papers, papers, and more papers



Cost to Study ☹️

- ▶ **Tuition**
 - Main: \$5,392 (semester)
 - Clermont: \$2,605 (semester)
- ▶ **Housing**
 - Dorm: \$3–4,000 (semester)
 - Apartments: \$400 a month and up, total
- ▶ **Food**
 - Meal plans are available, \$300–2,000 depending
- ▶ **Books**
- ▶ **Student Insurance**
 - \$980, can be waived
