Summer School Participants are expected to cover their travel and accommodation expenses. Summer School organizer will provide local transfer from the airport, train or bus station. A variety of accommodation options are available, from simple room only accommodation through to comfortable en-suite rooms including breakfast and evening meals. Youth Hostel

The students of the Summer School have the opportunity to live in the Student Dormitory, 2' walk from the Faculty, which also functions as a youth hostel. Youth Hostel offers their guests rooms with three beds and internet access. They can be occupied with only two or one guest if so reserved. Toilets and showers are in common use. Meals are provided for groups only, upon previous arrangement. Hostel guests have a possibility of free parking in the parking lot in front of the building.

Hotel Creina***

Hotel Creina is a three star hotel offering recently renovated rooms. Offer includes free internet access in the rooms and free wireless internet access in reception, bar and restaurant area. The hotel is located in a walking distance from the Faculty (15').

Fees
