



**About the SuMoS workshop:**

The aim of the workshop is to exchange experiences, discuss challenges in student mobility, and encourage collaboration and innovative solutions.

The workshop is organized as part of the [SuMoS project – Strengthening the ecosystem for sustainable student mobility](#). The project is co-funded by the **Erasmus+ programme** (KA220-HED – Partnerships for Cooperation in Higher Education) and aims to improve the institutional framework for strategic, structured, and sustainable collaboration between higher education institutions in the field of student mobility. This will be achieved through the development and purposeful use of green practices, digital tools, and curriculum comparison approaches.

Partners from **five European countries** have laid the foundation for the **Institutional Student Mobility Ecosystem (ISME)**. To further develop and expand this ecosystem, workshops will be organized in each partner country, bringing together key stakeholders, including vice-deans for international cooperation, international office staff, Erasmus coordinators and academic advisors / ECTS coordinators.
