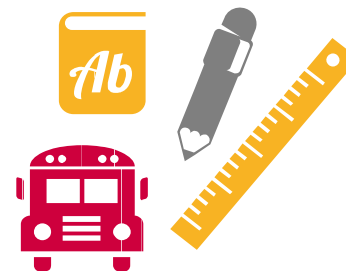

Student buddy

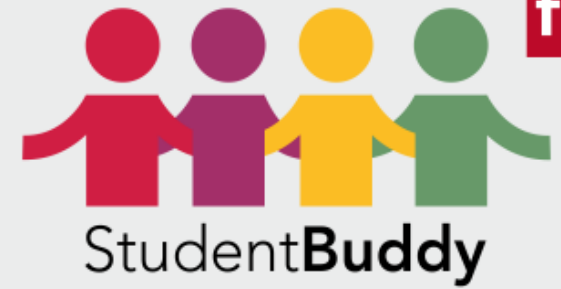
- Each Erasmus incoming student gets a **FOI buddy** who shows him around and helps him in the integration process

- **Increase** incoming and outgoing **student mobility**

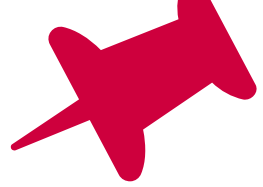

Top 10 tips and tricks to survive Žilina:
